

# **Data Protection Declaration for Website Visitors**

pursuant to Art. 13 GDPR

We process your data exclusively on the basis of the statutory provisions of GDPR Art. 6 Para. 1, f. Our website informs our customers and interested parties about the services and products of our company and offers information on specific topics. We also present our employees on this website and provide contact information such as a route map, telephone number and e-mail address/contact form.

#### Contact with us

If you contact us via e-mail, the data you provide will be stored by us for the purpose of processing the enquiry and possible follow-up questions. We do not forward this data without your consent.

#### **Cookies**

Our website uses so-called cookies. These are small text files that are deposited on your device with the help of your browser. They do not cause any damage. We use cookies merely to make our services user-friendly. Certain cookies remain on your device until you delete them. They enable us to recognise your browser next time you visit. If you do not want this to happen, you may use browser settings to inform you about the use of cookies, enabling you to permit this only on a case-by-case basis. If cookies are deactivated, the functions of this website may be restricted.

## Web analysis

We use Google Analytics, a web analysis service of Google LLC ("Google"). Google uses cookies. Information about your use of this website generated by the cookie will be forwarded to a Google server in the USA, where it will be stored.

Google is certified under the Privacy Shield Framework, guaranteeing compliance with European data protection law

(https://www.privacyshield.gov/participant?id=a2zt00000001L5AAI&status=Active).

Google will use this information on our behalf to evaluate the use of our website by the user, to compile reports on activities within this website and to render further services associated



with the use of this website and the internet. In this conjunction, processed data may be used to create pseudonymous user profiles.

We use Google Analytics only with activated IP anonymisation. This means the IP address of the user will be truncated by Google within the member states of the European Union or in other European Economic Area treaty states. The full IP address will be forwarded to a Google server in the USA only in exceptional cases, where it will be truncated.

The IP address forwarded by the browser of the user will not be merged by Google with other data. Users may reject the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on their browser software; users may also prevent Google from collecting data generated by the cookie and relating to their use of the website and from processing this data by downloading and installing the browser plug-in available at the following link:
